

## **Philippine Centre Charity Pageant Competition 2017**

**Little Miss PC Barrio Fiesta** candidates will be aged 5 - 12 years old, currently residing in the UK with one or both parents of Filipino origin.

**Miss Teen PC Barrio Fiesta** candidates will be aged 13 - 19 years old, currently residing in the UK with one or both parents of Filipino origin.

**Miss PC Barrio Fiesta** candidates will be age 20 - 30 year old, currently residing in the UK and of Filipino origin, single.

**Mrs PC Barrio Fiesta** candidates will be aged 31+ years old, currently residing in the UK and of Filipino origin, married, divorced, widow or single.

**Ms Lola PC Barrio Fiesta** candidates will be grandmothers, currently residing in the UK and of Filipino origin, married, divorced, widow or single.

Individual member and member organizations of the Philippine Centre and other Filipino based organizations may enter candidates for the competition as long as they abide by above requirements.

The Philippine Centre runs this charity competition each year in conjunction with the Barrio Fiesta celebration.

The funds raised from the competition help support the aims and objectives of the organization, a few are mentioned below:

- To promote the benefit of the public, in particular, FILIPINOS in the UK, to advance education and to provide facilities in the interest of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said persons.
- To relieve poverty, hardship or distress amongst Filipinos resident in the UK.
- To arrange and provide for cultural events, exhibitions meetings, lectures, classes (Tagalog & SAT's) seminars, library and resource facilities

## Terms & Conditions

1. A set of 1,500 raffle tickets will be distributed to the candidates. Candidates may request for more raffle tickets by contacting the Committee Chairperson.
2. Any unsold raffle tickets **MUST** be returned to Philippine Centre. **Candidates are liable for any lost tickets and are subject to payment of the lost tickets' face value.**
3. The winners will be determined by the most number of raffle tickets sold submitted at the time of the counting.
4. There will be TWO counting of the raffle ticket sales which will be done on **Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2017 and Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017** to be held at Hounslow Community Association.
5. Sold ticket stubs and unsold tickets **MUST** all be submitted to Philippine Centre on the last day of the counting. However, during the 1<sup>st</sup> canvassing (17<sup>th</sup> June) candidates may submit money without the ticket stubs during the counting, in agreement to submit all the stubs before the winning draw on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2017.

7. In the event of a tie i.e. having more than one winner with exactly the same amount of sales, both candidates will be awarded joint winners.
8. Prizes will be disclosed and confirmed to the candidates as soon as official sponsors of the Barrio Fiesta are finalised and agreed.
9. No buying or selling will take place during counting.
10. Only sold and paid for raffle tickets will be eligible for counting. **Cheques are not acceptable.**
11. Candidates may nominate watchers to oversee the counting of the sold raffle tickets.
12. The panel members who will be involved in the counting and decision of winners will be chosen from the members of the PC who have good standing abilities, who are neither officers nor any members involved with any of the candidates.
13. Winners will be declared and sashes distributed to all candidates. Candidates are all required to wear sashes and participate in the Barrio Fiesta parade on the **Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2017** which will take place in Apps Court Farm. They will need an escort and an arco during the parade.
14. Winners will be crowned and awarded prizes on the same day of the parade.
